MESSAGE FROM NKBA HEADQUARTERS

Hope you're enjoying a great spring! This month, we're focused on two important programs.

First, we are happy to reveal a terrific incentive plan for our **Specialty Badge** program. As you know, we unveiled this next phase in NKBA's ongoing professional development at KBIS in February. Badges convey a depth of knowledge in a specific discipline, and are open to all facets of the industry — not strictly designers, as is the case with our AKBD, CKBD and CMKBD certifications.

The program made its debut with the following five badges, which were created by the NKBA and tested by qualified NKBA member subject matter experts (SMEs): Remodeling, Living in Place, Cabinetry, Floor Plans & Specifications and Sales & Marketing.

Please talk up the badge program at chapter meetings and encourage your members to enroll for these microcredentials. The program directs applicants to study materials, and the initial fee of \$199 includes the testing fee and access to the online Knowledge Base. Subsequent badges are \$149, and individuals may hold as many badges as they like. A total of 15 badges will ultimately be rolled out.

So, here's "what's in it for you:" The three chapters whose members buy the most badges (minimum of 20 badges to qualify) between May 1 and July 31 will earn attendance packages to KBIS 2020! The 1st place chapter can bring three committee members to KBIS 2020; 2nd place, two committee members, and 3rdplace, one committee member. The package includes airfare to Las Vegas and three nights' hotel accommodations. We hope this terrific incentive will encourage your membership to go for this great credential – it's good for all of you – and to spur them to join chapter committees for a chance to earn a trip to KBIS.

Next, it's that time once again: Chapter Officer Election season!

Officer nominations are open from May 6 to June 14. All officers are chosen via self-nomination. Individuals who wish to be considered for a position must login and will be directed to open slots, with their applications sent to the National Recruitment Committee. Finally, we'd like to update you on our individual chapter web pages for all chapters. Due to a technology update, this project will be delayed several months. We received great feedback during chapter officer training at KBIS. With new functionality requests that have been made by the chapters, we have delayed the launch of these web pages until most items are addressed. • Chapter Elections – Opens May 6!

The 2020 Election Schedule will be emailed to all officers on May 1 and Self-Nominations will open on May 6. Open positions for 2020 are President, Programs Chair, and Communications Chair. Individuals currently in this role are eligible to self-nominate for a second two-year term which will begin 1-1-20 through 12/31/21.

• Chapter Funding – Final Deadline May 15

All chapters must submit proof your tax filing was accepted by the IRS by May 15. Send a copy of the "Accepted" status to <u>chapters@nkba.org</u>. This is the final document required for your chapter to receive Compliance Funding.
